Wednesday, November 1	
Star of the Week:	N/A
Small Group:	Children will match rhyming pictures. Children will talk about words that rhyme with the word, "at."
Circle Time:	Introduce monthly focuses: letters, number, shape, color, Christian Value, Peace and word wall words.
Activity:	Teacher will read the book, <i>Hop on Pop</i> . "Hop on Pop" rhyming activity- Children will hop on bubble wrap and say a rhyming word each time they hop.
State Standard Focus:	Phonological Awareness: With modeling and support, recognize and produce rhyming words.

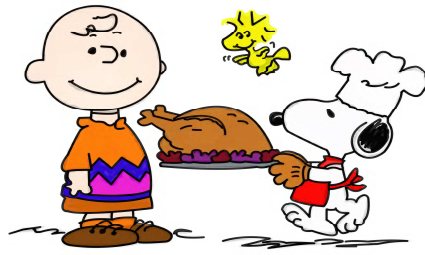
Friday, November 3	
Star of the Week:	N/A
Small Group:	Children will cut a square. Accommodation for fine motor: If a child has difficulty cutting with scissors, we will give them the "bounce-back" scissors to use.
Circle Time:	We will watch a video clip of Sesame Street, Rhyming Day.
Activity:	Children will play a rhyming memory game.
State Standard Focus:	Memory: With modeling and support remember and use information for a variety of purposes.



Monday, November 6	
Star of the Week:	Khloe
Small Group:	Children will lace the letter I. Accommodation for fine motor: Teacher may need to help with lacing.
Circle Time:	We will discuss what a leader is, voting and Presidents of the United States.
Activity:	The children will use coins, crayons and paper to make a coin rubbing.
State Standard Focus:	Small Muscle: Coordinate the use of hands, fingers and wrist to manipulate objects and perform tasks requiring precise movements.

Wednesday, November 8	
Star of the Week:	Khloe
Small Group:	Children will use an ABC pattern to make a red, white and blue star pattern.
Circle Time:	Letter V, "voting." The children will vote for a pajama day or hat day.
Activity:	The children will draw a picture of themselves as President. They will think about what they would want to do if they became president. The teacher will write the child's words on their paper.
State Standard Focus:	Writing Applications and Composition: With modeling and support, use a combination of drawing, dictating and emergent writing for a variety of purposes.

Star of the Week:	Khloe
Small Group:	Children will use play dough to make a square shape.
Circle Time:	Review voting. Discuss who the presidents are on the coins.
Activity:	Our class will do a penny science experiment together. We will put a penny into three different cups of liquid, (water, soap & water and salt & vinegar). The children will make observations and discuss what they see.
State Standard Focus:	Inquiry: Make careful observations

Star of the Week:	Audrey
Small Group:	Children will trace the number 6. Accommodation for fine motor: A few of the students may need to use a small broken crayon to help them with their finger grasp.
Circle Time:	What are we thankful for? Visit Pastor Maggie.
Activity:	The children will make friend cards using stickers, markers, crayons and paper. (Exchange them on Wednesday)
State Standard Focus:	Expression of Ideas and Feelings through the Arts: Express interest in and show appreciation for the creative work of others.

Small Group:	Children will string six beads on a pipe cleaner. Accommodation for fine motor: provide larger beads and/or teacher assistance if needed.
Circle Time:	Children will have a card exchange
Activity:	Children will use small plastic bottles, corn kernels, ribbon and stickers to make a corn shaker.
State Standard Focus	Expression of Ideas and Feelings through the Arts: Express interest in and show appreciation for the creative work of others.
