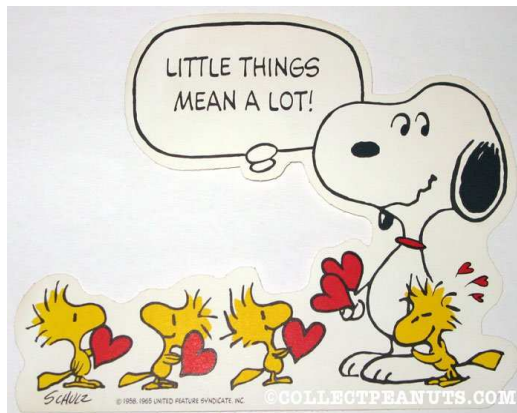


Ms. Cook and Mrs. Britt's Lesson plan for February 2018

Friday, February 2

State Standard Focus:	Number sense and counting: Understand that the last number of objects counted.

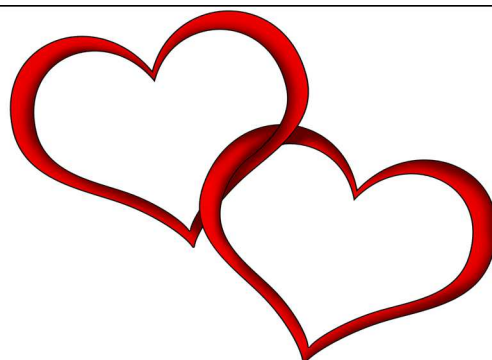
Friday, February 9

State Standard Focus:	Small muscle: Use classroom and household tools independently with eye-hand coordination to carry out activities.



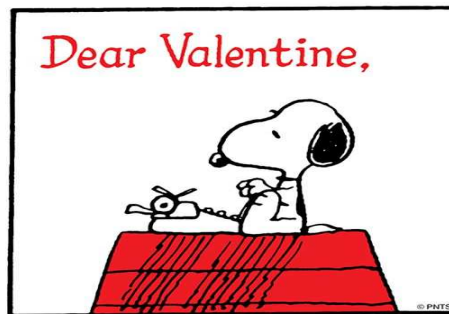
Monday, February 12	*Children will visit with Pastor Maggie

State Standard Focus:	Small Muscle: Coordinate the use of hands, fingers and wrists to manipulate objects and perform tasks requiring precise movements.



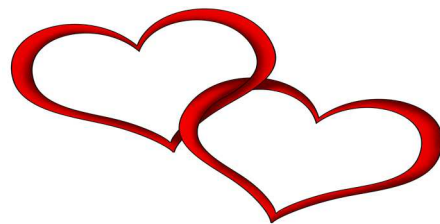
