Reading Readiness

I can recognize rhyming words (cat/hat, dog/frog, book/hook)

I can recite the alphabet clearly and vowels (a e i o u)

I recognize these letters:

A B C D E F G H I J K L M N O P Q R S T U V W X Y Z

a b c d e f g h i j k l m n o p q r s t u v w x y z

I can identify these sounds:

I can rote count to:

Visual/Motor Development

I can throw, catch, balance on one foot (left/right), run, walk on balance beam, jump with two feet, ride a tricycle

I can hold my pencil correctly, draw basic shapes (circle, square), trace my first name, write my first name, color within the lines

I can use scissors correctly, cut on a straight line, cut out a circle

I can draw/paint recognizable pictures
