Monday, December 3	*PRACTICE CHRISTMAS PROGRAM
Star of the Week:	
Circle Time:	We will read aloud, <i>The Mitten</i> . We will sing the Letter Sound song. Children will make an ABA mitten pattern.
Activity:	Each child will lace a mitten. *Work on Christmas gifts.
State Standard Focus:	Topic: Small Muscle: Touch Grasp, Reach, Manipulate. Coordinate the use of hands, fingers, and wrists to manipulate objects and perform tasks requiring precise movement.

Tuesday, December 4	*PRACTICE CHRISTMAS PROGRAM
Star of the Week:	
Circle Time:	We will read aloud, <i>Sneezy the Snowman</i> . Children will make an ABA colored snow hat pattern. *Practice the Christmas program.
Activity:	We will make hot chocolate. Children will count how many marshmallow's they will put in their hot chocolate.
State Standard Focus:	Topic: Number Sense and counting. Demonstrate one-to-one correspondence when counting objects up to 10.

Circle Time:	We will watch a video clip- Sesame Street: Repair Monster. Children will make an ABA snow hat pattern. Children will play, Find the Mouse. Children will guess what number the mouse is hiding under.
Investigation Day: Architecture. Concept: Building materials.	Children will explore wood workshop tools. Examples: nails, hammer, tape measure, screws, plywood and bolts.
State Standard Focus:	Topic: Safety Practices. With modeling and support identify and follow basic safety rules.

Circle Time:	We will read aloud, <i>Dr. Seuss's ABC</i> . Children will discuss rhyming words.
Investigation Day: Architecture. Concept: Structural design.	Children will use clay to build a structural design.
State Standard Focus:	Topic: Sense of Competence. Show confidence in own abilities and accomplish routine and familiar adults.

Circle time:	We will read, <i>All I want for Christmas</i> .
Activity:	Christmas tree math art
State Standard Focus:	Topic: Data Analysis. Collect data by categories to answer simple questions.

Circle Time:	We will read, <i>The Legend of the Candy Cane</i> . Children will make an ABA candy cane pattern. We will sing the Letter Sound Song.
Activity:	Children will make a candy cane using beads and pipe cleaners. *Work on Christmas gifts.
State Standard Focus:	Topic: Patterning. Create patterns.

Star of the Week:	<b>Madden</b>
Circle Time:	We will read aloud, <u>Chicka, Chicka, Boom, Boom</u> . We will sing the Letter Sound song.
Activity:	Children will make a jingle bell necklace. *Work on Christmas gifts.
State Standard Focus:	Topic: Patterning. Create patterns.

State Standard Focus:	Topic: Innovation and intervention. Use imagination and creativity to interact with objects and materials.
