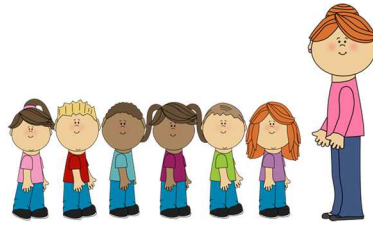

We will also teach our Christian Value, Self-Control, 1 Peter 1:13 "So think clearly and exercise self-control." We will talk about how we can be part of a group, share with others, and be good citizens. This month will also be our first visit with public safety officer Nicholas Lambert of the Huber Heights Police Department.

I have had many parents asking questions about behaviors. In our 3's class we are all learning to be part of a group and to be courteous students. This year our main goals are to focus on social and emotional development and begin to explore academics. Sharing will come to them as we continue this year! All my kids have great kind hearts and I have no worries about us all getting along and playing well and learning! If I ever have a problem in class with your student, I will always contact you either at pick up, a phone call, send you a Remind message or an email. If you do not receive a daily behavior report from me, this means your student had a good day! I utilize a "bad choices chair" where a child may need to sit for 3 minutes for behaviors such as hitting, throwing toys, or not listening to a teacher in a safety situation. I do reward kindness and good behavior! If I see your child helping a friend, comforting a sad friend, or helping a teacher, I will send home a note and reward them by allowing them to pick a prize from our treasure box! I appreciate all of my involved parents this year! It is always refreshing to have such amazing families and children in my class! I love my kids and I can't wait to share this exciting month with them!
