If I see your child helping a friend, comforting a sad friend, or helping a teacher, I will send home a note and reward them by allowing them to pick a prize from our treasure box! I appreciate all of my involved parents this year! It is always refreshing to have such amazing families and children in my class! I love my kids and I can't wait to share this exciting month with them!
