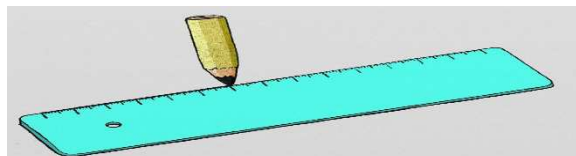

Bible Verse: SELF CONTROL: "So think clearly and exercise self-control." 1 Peter 1:13

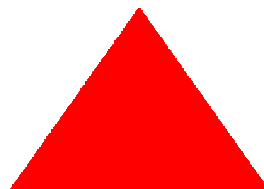
Monday, October 2nd	Measurement Week
