Families, we had a "Family Work" project called, The Kissing Hand. This project was to help children with the transition from home to school. We read the book, The Kissing Hand and met our class pet, Chester. The kisses that you sent in were placed on a heart and set in a basket. At any time the children can take their kisses and hold their friend Chester. There is still time if you didn't have a chance to do the project. Just put some lipstick on your lips and kiss a piece of blank paper. Mom or dad or another caregiver can do this activity. Please return this paper in your child's back pack. Explorers Investigation:

Explorers started out the year with a germ investigation. They explored the distance the germs can go, how to kill germs, what has germs, and types of germs. Helpful tips to know:

How your child plays, learns, speaks, acts, and moves offers important clues about your child's development.

Developmental milestones are things most children can do by a certain age.

Movement milestones for 3 & 4 year olds

- Hops and stands on one foot up to five seconds
- Goes upstairs and downstairs without support
- Kicks ball forward
- Throws ball overhand
- Catches bounced ball most of the time
- Moves forward and backward with agility
