Is your preschool crying at drop off?

The start of [preschool](#) is a milestone that's often anticipated with great excitement and joy, but also with crying sometimes. Crying may happen from both the children and the parents. Here are some ways for you and your child to ease the separation anxiety and to successfully start this new adventure -- together and apart!

Be Consistent-Some moms may want to immediately decide to pull him/her out of the classroom if they are

upset. Remember this could deny the child an opportunity to learn how to work through negative feelings.

Consistency is key when it comes to making [preschool](#) a part of your child's new routine. Simply going together on a regular basis will provide your little one with a strong sense of anticipation. Keep your goodbyes short and sweet so that your child knows what to expect but doesn't prolong your departure. When you pick him up at the end of the day, reinforce the idea that you came back, just like you said you would.

Get the Teacher Involved-

A teacher can be a warm, caring, and experienced individual who can anticipate her students' needs. But since she is new to you too, brief her with necessary information that will help her and your child get to know each other better.

Remember that starting [preschool](#) is a big step and a positive step for your child and for you.
